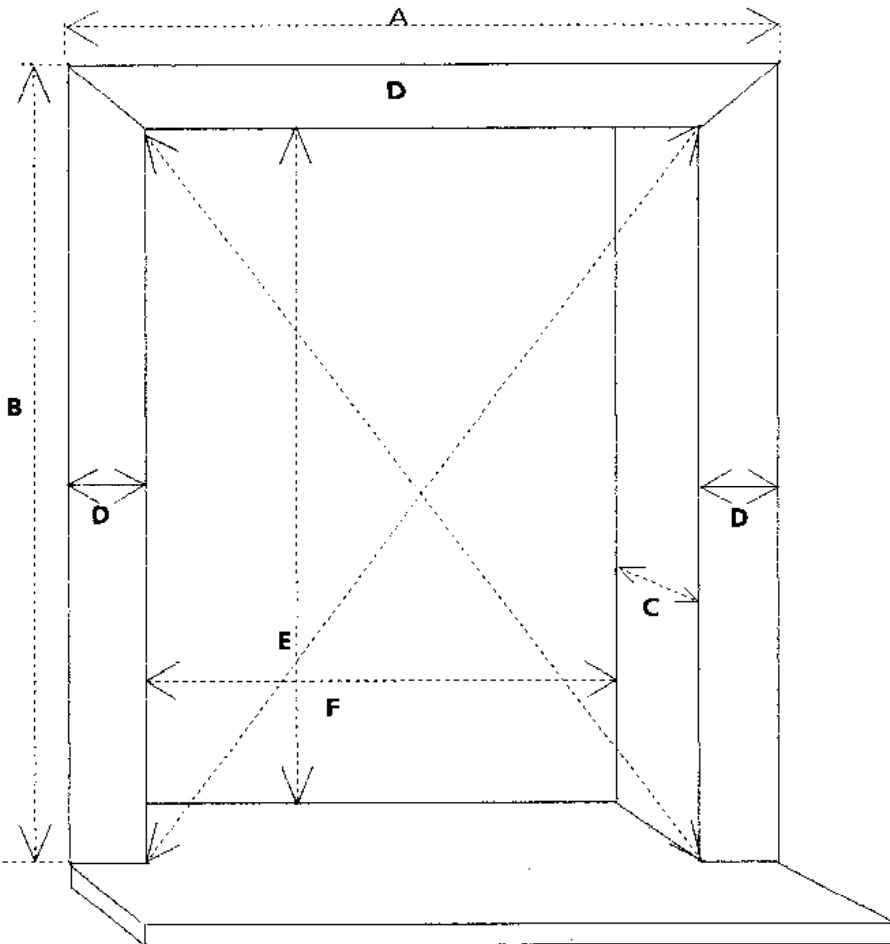


how to measure shutters

Accurate measuring is very important. Please use the information below to check your measurements. The most crucial measurement for reveal or inside fix is the diagonal, to check if the window is square. If the window is out of square you will require side scribes to fit shutters to. Please check for the position of window handled and locks.

Codes for drawing below:

- A= Window width for face fixing.
- B= Window height for face fixing.
- C= Reveal depth (check for handles and locks).
- D= Architrave width.
- E= Reveal height. Check height Left, center & right use the smallest size
- F= Reveal width. Check top, center & bottom use to smallest size.
